Painting Guidelines, Restrictions and Locations	<p>For inclusion in this show, please submit paintings from the any Nashville Metro Parks.</p> <p>THIS SHOULD BE AN EASY SHOW IN WHICH TO PARTICIPATE. Please use existing pieces. They can be of any of the Metro Parks: Centennial Park, Percy and Edwin Warner, Shelby, Lockeland Springs, but it must be a METRO PARK.</p> <p>We will submit to our partners however many pieces are submitted. 25 or so will be selected by Centennial Arts Center to be hung at the one-night event. Any pieces that do not sell at the in-person show will be featured in our ONLINE SHOW.</p> <p>THERE ARE NO FORMAL PAINT OUTS scheduled for this event.</p>

<p>Painting Submissions</p>	<p><u>Number and Sizes of Paintings Allowed (sizes not including frames)</u> You may submit any number of pieces of Metro Parks. No size limits.</p> <p><u>Subject Matter</u> Must be of an official Metro Park</p> <p><u>Frames</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Solid wood construction • Since we are a plein air painting organization, plein air style frames are recommended, but not required (Google “plein air frames images” for examples.) Floater frames are acceptable. • Gold, silver, bronze, black, white and single-tone wood frames, and deep-edged, gallery-wrapped canvases are acceptable • All others, distressed wood, and low-quality frames not acceptable <p><u>Pricing</u> Pricing is up to the artist.</p>
