

While there are nearly 100 miles to choose from (see website link below), and paintings from any of the greenways will be ccepted, remember that the event will be held at the Richland Creek Greenway and hat will be our area of focus. Wildlife seen on the Richland Creek Greenway includes eron, turkey, hawk, deer, coyote, duck, songbirds, raccoon, turtles, otters, and fox. isit the Greenways for Nashville site <u>greenwaysfornashville.org</u> , use the menu to find a hap and details about the greenway you are interested in. <i>Wildlife reference photos (if used) must be the artist's own original photographs taken</i> <i>y the artist. Please have photographs available in the event an issue arises.</i>
 Painting Guidelines If you paint along the paved trails, please remember that they are two-way and multi-use. Find an area just off the path to paint to avoid blocking the path for others and for your own safety. Please note that the trails and bridges may be slippery or uneven. For more details: greenwaysfornashville.org Remember, the buddy system is the safest way to travel and paint! Please review and abide by our "Leave No Trace and Member Etiquette" guidelines. PARKING	Richland Creek Greenway is a loop with many walkup access points, trailheads, and parking lots. See map at end of this document and links to parking areas for points of interest on Richland Creek Greenway. <i>Parking areas are indicated on map</i> :
	NOTE: all trails around the Richland Creek Greenway are paved and mostly barrier free. They readily accommodate rolling your paint gear. If you lack a rollable device, packing gear into an old suitcase with rollers is a great option.

	easels with dedicated lighting.
	• Please refrain from using heavy frames on larger painting sizes within the Medium size category (e.g., 12x16, 14x18, and 16x20). Our 3-panel display systems were not
	designed to support exceptionally heavy paintings.
FRAMING GUIDELINES	Acceptable
	Solid Wood Construction
	• Gold, silver, bronze, black, brown, and single tone-stained wood frames, with or
	without gold or silver trim liner lips. Since we are a plein air painting organization,

	plein air style frames are recommended, but not required (search plein air frames and click images for examples).
	• Plein air styled floater frames with a painted exposed edge of the panel or canvas.
	• Tasteful, subdued, color-painted frames, for example: white, off-white, pale green,
	antiqued gray or blue, etc.
	• All works on paper must be protected under glass or plexi-glass. White or off-white
	mats are recommended.
	NOT Acceptable
	Plastic wood-like frames.
	 Roughly distressed wood frames.
	• Low-quality or damaged frames.
	 Picture frames with an attached fold-out easel.
	 Unframed, gallery-wrapped canvases.
	Paper mats must be framed under glass.
PRICING OF WORKS	A minimum price of \$250.00 has been established for this show. Any work submitted
	below that price will automatically be adjusted to the minimum price of \$250.00
